

Michigan State Veterinary Recipe

Mix in blender

Original Version

1 Tablespoon Honey
1 tbsp whipping cream
2 egg yolks
1 can Pet evaporated milk

My Version (substitutions)

1 tablespoon Light Karo Syrup
1 tbsp whipping cream
2 egg yolks
12 oz H₂O and 3 scoops of Powdered Goats Milk

Dissolve in pan on stove 2 packages Knox unflavored gelatin
Combine all of the ingredients together
Add one more can of water (12 ounces). Blend well. Refrigerate.

This turns to a pudding state, but dissolves when warmed.

Notes from another eskie breeder:

At four weeks I start puppies on pabulum added to above formula....either rice or oatmeal. I alternate.

By 5 weeks I have added yogurt (about a tsp at the beginning and up it as they grow.) I give the yogurt separately from the pabulum and formula.

I start adding puppy food mashed up and reducing the milk formula and pabulum by six weeks also adding some cottage cheese. By 12 weeks each pup is getting about 1/4 cup three times a week of either the yogurt or the cottage cheese.

Future Notes:

1 container of whipping cream is only needed for the duration.

6 Tablespoons wheat germ	1.5 oz wheat germ
1 package Knox unflavored gelatin	1 pkg Knox unflavored gelatin
2 Tablespoons vegetable oil	2 tablespoons vegetable oil
2 Tablespoons unsulphured molasses	2 Tablespoons unsulphured molasses
Pinch of salt	Pinch of salt
